Our Strengths

- Staff are able to add value to students through the teaching and learning process.

Our Weaknesses

- Staff are not able to ensure academically low achievers achieve 5Es in the HKCEE.
- Poor English standards amongst students.

Our Opportunities

- Members of the local community regard the college as one of the good band 2 schools in Tin Shui Wai.
- The image of the college as a “value-added” school helps to attract many new S1 students of average ability (band 2).

Our Threats

- More and more primary schools will feeder link with secondary schools operated by the same school sponsoring body (SSB) under the “through train” mode. The college may have difficulties to recruit students from primary schools.
- Many students are “internet” or “on-line game” addicts and spend inadequate time on their studies.
