#### Our Threats

- More and more primary schools will feeder link with secondary schools operated by the same school sponsoring body (SSB) under the "through train" mode. The college may have difficulties to recruit students from primary schools.
- Many students are "internet" or "on-line game" addicts and spend inadequate time on their studies.
